How You Can Detect Genuine New (Polymer) Banknotes

Features for Lower Denominations \$50, \$100 and \$500 Features for Higher Denominations \$1000, \$2000 and \$5000









FEEL



Run your fingers over the top right hand corner of the back of the note to feel the raised dots feature, which is for the visually impaired.

Applies to all 6 Banknotes.

LOOK

When the note is held up to light:



A clear window can be seen from both the front and the back of the note.

Applies to all 6 Banknotes.



The letters BOJ appear in an area of coloured print. Applies to all 6 Banknotes.

TILT

As you tilt the note:





Areas with a shimmering gold ink can be seen on the \$50, \$100 and \$500 only.



The colours of the images in the holographic foil change. The holographic foil is on the \$1000, \$2000 & \$5000 only.





There is a silver ink that has a highly reflective mirror-like finish on the \$50, \$100 and \$500 only.

CHECK

Using an ultra-violet (UV) light:







Some areas of the note glow in 2 colours. Applies to all 6 Banknotes.







The denomination appears. Applies to all 6 Banknotes.
