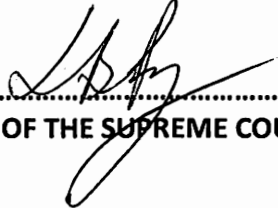
UPON THE HEARING OF THE FIXED DATE CLAIM FORM filed by the Director of Public Prosecutions and dated 16th October, 2025 and coming up for hearing this day and upon hearing Counsel for the Applicant, *Mr. Malike Kellier* as instructed by the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. That **QDi.317 Name: 1: AHMAD 2: HUSSAIN 3: AL-SHARAA previously known as 1: ABU-MOHAMMED 2: AL JAWLANI** was designated as a listed entity under the Terrorism Prevention Act.
2. In accordance with section 14 (1) (a) of the Terrorism Prevention Act, **QDi.317 Name: 1: AHMAD 2: HUSSAIN 3: AL-SHARAA previously known as 1: ABU-MOHAMMED 2: AL JAWLANI** designated as terrorist entity by the United Nations Security Council and whose information were amended to the United Nations Sanctions List under Reference Number DPPA/SCAD/SCSOB/2025/SCA/2/25 (09) dated October 16, 2025 are hereby declared as listed entity for the purposes of the Terrorism Prevention Act.
3. In accordance with section 6 (1) of the **Terrorism Prevention Act**, no person in Jamaica or no Jamaican in or outside of Jamaica shall knowingly:
 - a. deal directly or indirectly with any property that is owned or controlled by or on behalf of the above listed entity.
 - b. enter into or facilitate, directly or indirectly, any transactions in respect of that property that is owned or controlled by on behalf of the above-mentioned listed entity
 - c. provide any financial or related services in respect of that property that is owned or controlled by or on behalf of the above-mentioned listed entity.
 - d. Convert any property owned or controlled by or on behalf of the below mentioned entities or take any steps to conceal or disguise that property is owned or controlled by or on behalf of the above-mentioned listed entity.

4. This Order(s) herein remain in effect except or until an Order is made by the Court for any exemption in accordance to section 14 (B) or 14(C) of the Terrorism Prevention Act or otherwise revoked or modified.
5. The Applicant's attorney is to prepare, file and serve a copy of this Order along with a copy of UN document DPPA/SCAD/SCSOB/2024/SCA/2/25 (09) dated October 16, 2025, issued by the United Nations Security Council Sanctions List Committee on all relevant authority and financial institutions.
