Extension of Waiver of ACH Value Threshold

Charges for Transaction Breaches

Bank of Jamaica (the Bank) advises the public that further to the advisory issued on 23 December 2025 - ***Waiver of ACH Value Threshold Charges for Transaction Breaches***, and based on representation from some Deposit Taking Institutions (DTIs), an extension has been granted in relation to the waiver of the J\$5000 penalty charge applicable to transactions equal to and exceeding the Automated Clearing House (ACH) value threshold of one million dollars (J\$1,000,000). This waiver, which was previously scheduled to end on **Wednesday, 31 December 2025**, will now remain in effect **until Friday, 16 January 2026**.

The extension of the waiver has been granted to provide for continuity and stability within the national payment system, while allowing affected DTIs to ensure full resolution of internal challenges in relation to timely crediting of some of their customers' accounts within the extended timeframe.

For absolute clarity, be advised that ACH transaction fees charged by DTIs remain in effect.
