2. All Orders previously issued by this Court in respect of the aforementioned listed individuals/entities being the Defendants herein shall cease to apply to said individuals/entities as of May 21, 2026.
3. The Applicant's attorney is to prepare, file and serve a copy of this Order along with a copy of UN document DPPA/SCAD/SCSOB/2025/SCA/2/26 (06) dated May 21, 2026, issued by the United Nations Security Council Sanctions List Committee on all relevant authority and financial institutions.
